RULES & CONDITIONS

1. Entries are open until FRIDAY, 26th October 2018.
2. The competition has no theme. Any item can be entered providing it is made primarily from wood.
3. The item must be made by the person entering the competition.
4. The item must be made primarily from wood. Small amounts of mixed media are, however, acceptable.
5. The item cannot have been entered into and won a prize at any other similar competition, including last year's Artists who Wood competition.
6. Persons entering the under 18 category must be aged under 18 at the time of entry.
7. Please fill in one entry form per item entered into the competition.
8. A maximum of two items may be entered per category per person. For example, a person under 18 may in theory enter a maximum of six items (two per category).
9. Items entered into the competition will be exhibited during the Eden Whale Festival at the exhibition venue in Eden. Space may be limited. In the unlikely event that we run out of exhibition space we'll do our best to rotate the display.
10. Entrants are responsible for delivering and picking up of the entered items to the exhibition venue for judging and exhibiting.
11. Exhibition Venue (to be confirmed)
 - a. Delivery of entries between 2pm & 4pm, Friday 2nd November.
 - b. Pick up Sunday, 4th November 3pm.
12. The results of the competition will be announced through local and social media. All entrants grant permission to the organisers and sponsors to publish and / or broadcast the names and photographs of the finalists, the winners and their entries through print and electronic media.
13. Judging will be by a panel and judges' decisions are final. Judging will take place on Friday, 2nd November.
14. The organisers or the Artists who Wood competition and exhibition, and organisers of the Eden Whale Festival take no responsibility or liability for any damage caused to entered items during the setting up and exhibition period.
