All work must demonstrate the re-use and recycling of materials that would otherwise be considered 'waste'.

Entries to the **Reuseable / Repurpose Category** must demonstrate the use of goods (that would otherwise have been discarded or throw out) that have been turned into a totally new useable way utilising the old item/s.

The **Art / Sculpture category** can again must take goods (that would otherwise have been discarded or throw out) that have been turned into a work of art or sculpture.

The **Repurpose it Competition** is open to all community members of any age, who live in the Bega Valley, Eurobaodalla, Cooma-Monaro, Bombala and Snowy Mountain shires. Mallacoota residents can also entry the competition.

All work will be part of the 2019 **Repurpose it Competition** exhibition running from Friday, 1st November to Sunday, 3rd November 2019.

Entries are required to deliver their work on Wednesday, 30th October to Eden for exhibition between 2 – 4pm. Exhibition Centre will be advised.

Entrants are required to **collect their work on Sunday, 3rd November at 2pm.**

Judging will be by a panel and judges' decisions are final. Judging will take place on Friday, 2nd November with awards announced following judging. **Winners need to be present at Exhibition 6:00pm.**

The results of the competition will be announced through local and social media. All entrants grant permission to the organisers and sponsors to publish and / or broadcast the names and photographs of the finalists, the winners and their entries through print and electronic media.

Judges and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.

IMPORTANT: Repurpose it Competition entries must:

Be safe for public exhibition

Be self-supporting ie. It cannot be hung from the ceiling OR from the wall.

NOT exceed a size limit :

2 dimensional – 1.5 x 1.5 metres and 3 dimensional – 1.5 x 1.5 x 1.5 metres

NOT exceed a weight limit of 20kgs

Entry items must be made by the person entering the competition.

The item cannot have been entered into and won a prize at the previous year's Repurpose It competitions.

The organisers will take all reasonable care in handling and dealing with works submitted. However the organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage incurred to any of the artworks or materials. Work remains the property of the entrant.
