**Stall Guidelines:** Stallholders must provide their own signage, tables, equipment, marquees and tent pegs or sandbags for anchoring and any other requirements. Vehicles must be offsite by designated hours. **All marquees must be secure with appropriate weights to hold marquee safely and securely.** 

Food Guidelines: Only fresh quality food products are to be marketed and sold. All food products must be sold in accordance with State and Federal food preparation and handling regulations.

Stall holders selling food and beverages must comply with the NSW Food Authority's Guidelines for Food Businesses at Temporary Events. ALL Stall Holders are strongly encouraged to provide their own generator, as electrical sites will be limited to 5 or less.

ALL stallholders must comply with the Eden Whale Festival Committee's vision promoting environmentally sustainable practices and be free from single use plastic products. This includes plastic bags, Styrofoam containers, plastic utensils and straws. A \$50 surcharge will be imposed on breaches of this condition.
